### **POLICY HANDBOOK FOR 2021/2022**

The teachers and director will be placing dancers in their appropriate level(s). Invitations to try alternate levels will come directly from the teachers and studio director.

### REGULAR DANCE CLASSES FOR MINIS

PRE-JUNIOR and JUNIOR JAZZ/TAP COMBO: Pre-Junior: age 4-5 years; Junior: 5-7 years
No experience is required and dancers will be placed by age and then moved, if deemed necessary.

Our combo classes (45 minutes), are an enjoyable yet structured introduction to both Tap and Jazz.

The basics of both disciplines will be introduced as well as encouraging new and exciting elements, all while discovering the joy and love of dance.

### **BALLET COMBO:** Pre-School (age 4 - 5 years)

No experience is required and dancers will be placed by age and then moved, if deemed necessary.

Our Ballet combo program is an introduction to ballet, music, coordination and of course, grace. A 30 minute class that will foster the love of dance for our mini ballerinas.

### **RAD BALLET GRADES:** Pre-Primary / Primary

No experience is required and dancers will be placed by age and then moved, if deemed necessary.

Pre-Primary/Primary is an introduction to Ballet that includes increased levels of coordination as well as an introduction to technique and discipline. A 45 minute class, sure to have your dancer twirling with excitement.

STRETCH 'N TUMBLE: This acrobatic and stretch program is for children age 5 and up who have had limited or introductory Acro experience or, who have completed our Stretch 'n Tumble programs in the past and are continuing to expand their Acro skills. These students will be introduced to acrobatics and also focus on flexibility. This class will be strictly for training purposes; choreography will not be offered.

A very popular Adult Stretch & Strength is relatively new to our DS programs, check out the info below!

STRETCH & STRENGTH: (This program will be offered from Sept to the Spring Break, 2022.) We are very excited to announce that we will be continuing with an Adult class for this inspirational program. The class will follow an aerobic and muscle conditioning format, designed with adults in mind. Improve your balance, aerobic endurance, flexibility and muscle tone and join in the fun. This Adult program will run from September 2021, pause during our Winter break and then run until our DS Spring Break, 2022. See a separate Adult Stretch & Strength form for further information and registration.

### Sessional Programs for Children 3-4 years; 3-6 years

**Twinkle, twinkle, little stars.....**Danscott is excited to offer sessional programs for our up and coming young stars. Need some fun and fancy for your child? New and exciting steps in every session! See below for the exciting details.

For children 3-4 years, we offer a "Tiny Toes" program: a program which is a fun introduction to dance, music and body movement. An experienced, mature instructor will be teaching our classes and we are sure that they will inspire and encourage our youngest stars! Our first session will begin in Sept and the classes will be scheduled for **Saturday** mornings. Our second session, will begin in November, 2021 and finish by mid Dec. A winter /spring/summer session will also be available and details will be available through the Danscott Office and also on our website in late fall. See the Tiny Toes handouts for all information and note that class size is limited so don't miss out on this fun opportunity.

For children 3-6 years, we also offer a program called Be-Dazzled! This is a monthly program with a new and creative theme each month. Students will make crafts weekly, enjoy a story time, participate in fun and engaging games and of course, dance! Our experienced teacher, can't wait to work with your child and explore the learning process together. Separate handouts, including detailed information and registration forms, are available on our website as well as the studio office.

### **PROPER DANCE ATTIRE**

Dancers must be properly dressed for their classes. No extra clothing such as T-shirts, sweat suits, etc., is to be worn over dance clothing. All hair must be secured back (pony tail, bun, etc.).

PRE-JUNIOR AND JUNIOR JAZZ/TAP COMBOS: <u>Girls:</u> proper body fitting dance attire, black patent tap shoes (Capezio or comparable tap shoe, ballet slippers as for Ballet Combo, Pre-Primary/Primary, for Jazz section)

**<u>Boys</u>**: short sleeved T-shirt, and shorts or sports pants; black tap shoes, white or black ballet slippers for Jazz section

### BALLET COMBO AND PRE-PRIMARY/PRIMARY - GIRLS

Short sleeve **pink**, cotton lycra, scoop neck leotard (Mondor style #1635 or #3535). Mondor Ballerina Pink tights, (Style #310, without seams). Soft pink ballet slippers (Bloch #205, with a full sole).

**BOYS BALLET DRESS REGULATIONS**: White short sleeved T-Shirt with navy or black cotton shorts. White or black leather ballet slippers with elastic across the instep.

STRETCH 'n TUMBLE / ACROBATICS A and B: Body fitting attire and bare feet. \*Please note that students are required to wear full length leggings, capri length shorts or longer shorts to mid thigh, to these classes. Hair must be secured back for females.

ADULT STRETCH & STRENGTH: any type of exercise wear and runners

We present a Showcase including all the regular classes for our Minis, with the exception of Stretch 'n Tumble or if you are in a sessional program, such as Tiny Toes, or Hip Hop / Street Jazz. All other regular classes attend our Dress Rehearsal on June 9 and also participate in both performances: Friday, June 10 at 6:30 pm and Saturday, June 11 at 1:00 pm. More information will be available in early spring, 2022. Watch for this exciting news.

### **DANCE COSTUMES**

Please remember that we will make every attempt to keep the cost of costumes down, but we also must consider the rising cost of dance fabric and necessary supplies. We also order many costumes from the United States so our cost also depends on the value of our dollar and the cost of shipping costumes through customs. Props or set pieces that may be required to enhance choreography, are also factored into costume costs. A costume brochure with detailed information and order form will be available for all our students in Sept/Oct. The Danscott office will be emailing this brochure to each of our families.

**SHOWCASE COSTUMES:** All costumes are chosen by the teachers. Parents are responsible for buying, altering slightly or enhancing if deemed necessary by the teacher. If you do not hand sew, please keep in mind that you may have to hire a seamstress for small alterations and consequently the price will be higher. **Approximate cost:** \$100.00

Please note that once costumes are ordered they are not able to be cancelled or any refunds issued.

### **PAYMENT PROCEDURES**

Danscott will be run on a post-dated cheque system. During the third week of classes, which is the week of September 20 you must come in to the studio office, which is located in our third studio, to leave your post-dated payments. If you registered in June, July or early August, you will receive a detailed fee statement with your dance class schedule by email. If you register in late August or September or have made changes to your dancer's schedule by adding or deleting classes, you will be emailed a new statement in Sept. Please note that all payments must be made on the 1st of the month and made payable to Danscott Studio. The September cheque will cover your monthly cost to dance for September, 2021 and also the final 4 weeks of dance, in our calendar year.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any returned or NSF cheques submitted or any fees that are submitted late or past deadlines. Delinquent accounts, past 30 days will result in a service and/or interest fees being attached as well as could result in your dancer being removed from our programs.

Danscott Studio will continue to accept credit card payments and also e-transfers. This service will be available to our families and arrangements can be made with the Danscott Admin, email danscottoffice@shaw.ca for details.

### WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Withdrawals will <u>not</u> be processed for any dancer withdrawing from any dance program or classes after November 30, 2021 and as outlined below, such written notice must be submitted to Danscott Studio no later than November 1, 2021. Please note that there are no withdrawals at anytime from our Sessional programs: Adult Stretch & Strength, Tiny Toes and Be-Dazzled.

Following the above time line for withdrawals, a <u>one month written notice</u> is required if a student wishes to withdraw or terminate a class or classes and reimbursement will be calculated from the 1st of the month following notice. If a dancer wishes to terminate all classes by the November deadline, a minimum of one month's written notice is also required. Possible reimbursement will be calculated and any post-dated cheques not required to complete outstanding fees, will be returned. Please note that discipline deposits that are received at the time of registration are non-refundable, if students are withdrawing. Families should also note that an administration fee will be added to process any withdrawal or refund. Letters of withdrawal may be given directly to a studio representative or by email directly to the office at danscottoffice@shaw.ca

### VERBAL NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Parents should also note that there will be no refunds issued for missed classes under any circumstances. Again, please note that Danscott Studio does not offer refunds or withdrawals from our Sessional Programs (Stretch & Strength Adult Program, Be-Dazzled and Tiny Toes), once registration has been received.

<u>Costume Deposits</u>: Parents are reminded that because our costume deposits are collected and submitted to our broker early in the fall, any students dropping a class or classes after Oct 5, 2021, will not be eligible for any costume refunds. These costume fees are non-refundable.

### DANCE CLASS VIEWING

**Spectators will not be allowed to view regular lesson times, however:** parents will be invited to view the last 15 minutes of dance classes in October, November, February and possibly March on scheduled viewing dates. The exact dates will be listed in the September newsletter, subject to Covid-19 restrictions in place at that time.


### **CONTACT / COMMUNICATION GUIDELINES**

In consideration of the Releasees allowing my child's participation in Danscott programs and Studio Events (as hereinafter defined), including access and use of Danscott facilities, I hereby agree, on my own behalf and on behalf of my child:

- To assume and accept all risks arising out of my participation.
